

How to Integrate Emerge with Rubín with Moodle

Step 1: Add Emerge with Rubín as an external tool

1. Click on a content block.
2. At the bottom of the block, click **Add an activity of resource**.
3. Select **External Tool** from the list that appears.
4. To the right of where it says **Preconfigured tool**, click the + sign.
5. On the External tool configuration page, enter the following information:
 - a. Tool name: Emerge with Rubín
 - b. Tool URL: use the URL the Rubín team provides
 - c. Tool description: leave blank
 - d. LTI version: LTI 1.0/1.1
 - e. Consumer key: rubin
 - f. Shared secret: use the shared secret the Rubín team provides
 - g. Custom parameters: leave blank
 - h. Default launch container: choose Embed
6. Click **Save changes** to add the external learning tool.
7. You have now added Emerge with Rubín as an external tool!

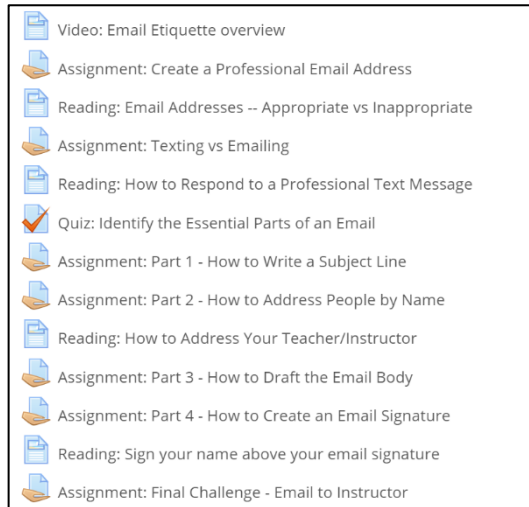
Step 2: Create an easy way to visit the Emerge with Rubin home page

1. Click on a content block.
2. At the bottom of the block, click **Add an activity of resource**.
3. Select **External Tool** from the list that appears.
4. For **Activity name**, use Emerge with Rubin home page.
5. In the **Preconfigured tool** area, click the drop-down list and select Emerge with Rubin.
6. Click **Save and display**.
7. You have added a link to the Emerge with Rubin home page!

Step 3: Assign an individual item from Emerge with Rubin

You can make any item in the Emerge program a simple, one-click-to-access item in your Moodle. Here's how.

1. Click on a content block.
2. At the bottom of the block, click **Add an activity of resource**.
3. Select **External Tool** from the list that appears.
4. For Activity name, use **copy the full name of any item** inside a module (example as shown below – **Assignment: Texting vs Emailing**). Items include Video, Activity/Assignment, Reading, Quiz and Pre- and Post-test and are labeled as such. For a reference point, here's the list of items from the Email Etiquette module:



5. In the **Preconfigured tool** area, click the drop-down list and select Emergence with Rubin.
6. Click **Save and display**.
7. You will now see the Emergence with Rubin activity open up within your Moodle course.

Step 4: Have students access Emerge with Rubin for the first time

1. When students click an Emerge item from your Moodle course, they will be taken to that item while still inside Moodle. They do not log into Emerge separately.

If students need to purchase access on their own, the material will remain hidden until purchase.

2. From the Emerge with Rubin home page, click "Step 1" to purchase course access. Once you purchase, copy the access code you see on the thank-you page.
3. Return to the program home page and click "Step 2" to enter the access code. Then, paste the access code in the box. Click "Submit."
4. You will return to the program home page and see all the content is now available.
